

FAQs: Rules and Regulations

WHAT CAN I SAY REGARDING VOTER REGISTRATION AS A CLINICIAN?

- Provide information about how patients can request a mail-in ballot or register to vote using Vot-ER
- Ask patients if they'd like to register to vote and refer patients to Vot-ER tools
 - vote and refer patients to Vot-ER tools Answer simple, factual questions
 - about candidates like party membership or if they're an incumbent/challenger



Do not state your party or candidate preferences



Do not mention policy positions or party platforms

In short, you must remain nonpartisan. Please refer to <u>vot-er.org/scripts</u> for examples of ways to engage in these conversations.

DO I HAVE TO GET APPROVAL TO WEAR/USE MY VOT-ER BADGE?

The vast majority of providers do not need to get approval. Like any other badge backer you choose to affix to your IDs, you are free to place information that is helpful to you and your patients on this space.

Remember: all voter registration happens on the patient's own phone and the information is entered by the patient, not you as the provider.
